2. Evaluation of KFTC's Technical Assistance

- Have room for Improvement
 - Mainly conducted through lectures rather than other methods
 - Often fail to meet the needs of recipients
 - Take much time and money

- No Chance to Compare to Donors' Diverse Programs
 - Possibility of Overlapping
 - No chance to Strengthen the strength and make up for the weakness
 - Worry about Excess of Supply between Donors

3. Coordination of Technical Assistance

- Need to Compare Donors' Diverse Programs
 - Avoid Overlapping
 - Strengthen the strength and make up for the weakness
 - Prevent Excess of Supply between Donors
- Provide a Practical Conversation about Each TA Program between Donors and Recipients
 - Authorities Discuss Direction of Improvement
