(i) FINANCE & ACCOUNT UNIT

Qualifications:

- Degree in Finance/Accounting or a related field recognized by the Government.
- Preferable up to 3 years of experience in a related field;

Responsibilities:

- Administering the matters of receipts and payments for MyCC (Malaysia Competition Commission).
- Preparing and coordinating the budget for the MyCC.
- Monitoring the performance of expenditures for MyCC.
- Preparing Financial Statements for MyCC in accordance with current accounting standards and established timelines.
- Compiling and analyzing financial and non-financial information to assist MyCC in decision-making.
- Serving as the secretariat for committees under the purview of the Financial and Accounting Unit's responsibilities
- Other tasks directed from time to time.

(ii) INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY UNIT

Qualifications:

- Degree in Information Technology / Computer Engineering / Networking Engineering / Cyber Security or any related field recognized by the Government.
- Preferable up to 3 years of experience in a related field;
- Good verbal and written communication skills, including the ability to research and analyse information and summarise and present it clearly in writing, are equally important.

Responsibilities:

- Assisting in analyzing program requirements within an organization. Involved in the design, coding, and maintenance of systems, with the ability to troubleshoot and solve problems related to programs, systems, and ICT Agency assets.
- Responsible for ICT Security in the Agency:
 - i. Conducting studies to identify ICT security threats periodically and recommending security solutions in line with current developments.
 - ii. Performing analysis tasks and proposing solutions for the organization's ICT security information, incident management, risk management, business continuity, ICT security audit management, formulating and endorsing organizational information security management policies, and utilizing information security management technology.
- Responsible for coordinating any ICT planning and implementing, monitoring, and evaluating ICT projects, including those that are complex, large-scale, and multifaceted.
- Responsible for coordinating any ICT planning and implementing, monitoring, and evaluating information management policies within an organization.
- Other tasks directed from time to time.
