The Malaysia Competition Commission (MyCC) is an independent body established under the Competition Commission Act 2010 to enforce the Competition Act 2010. Its main role is to protect the competitive process for the benefit of businesses, consumers and the economy.

The Malaysian Competition Act 2010, which came into effect on 1 January 2012, applies to all business activities within and outside of Malaysia as long as these activities have an impact on competition in the domestic market. Companies must ensure their business practices, contracts and dealings comply with the Act.
